- Proper installation, servicing & replacement techniques

Graduates earn a Certificate or Associate of Science degree, and are eligible to sit for the EPA Section 608 Certification.

- Installing, servicing & replacing units
- Testing equipment for safety & efficiency
- Upholding compliance with industry standards
- Diagnosing mechanical and electrical problems

Admission Requirements

Admission to the HVAC-R program requires:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Wonderlic SLE assessment score of 14 or higher

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- Valid California driver license
- No DUI convictions for the past 3 years

Applicants must have reliable plans for transportation, child care and time to devote to academic work outside of scheduled class hours.
