

Applicants must have completed a minimum of 34 units of general education prerequisite coursework with a GPA of 2.5 or higher in the following subjects at an accredited college or university:

Human Anatomy with lab Microbiology with lab Human Physiology with lab General Chemistry with lab Writing and Composition Intermediate Algebra or higher General Psychology Introduction to Sociology or Cultural Anthropology Introduction to Public Speaking/Oral Communication General Education (GE) Breadth Area C2 (minimum of 3.0 units in literature, philosophy, or foreign language)

Applicants must also:

- Have a current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification from the American Heart Association
- Evidence of a current California LVN license
- Complete health assessment/immunization/titers
- Have reliable plans for transportation/child care
- Have time to devote to school work outside scheduled class hours
