

- Recording, analyzing, and processing diagnostic data and observations made during the procedure for the interpreting physician
- Discretion and judgment in the performance of sonographic and/or noninvasive diagnostic services
- Communication skills with patients and colleagues
- Professional and ethical behavior
- Patient education related to medical ultrasound and other non-invasive diagnostic ultrasound techniques, and good health principles
- Professional development, critical thinking and reasoning skills, pertaining to interpersonal interactions and ethics

Graduates earn an Associate of Science Degree in Diagnostic Medical Sonography.

SJVC holds registry status with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT), which provides students a pathway to credentialing without a required number of post-graduate clinical/experiential hours. Upon graduation, students will be eligible to sit for the following exams, in the order noted. After successfully

passing these exams, students will earn the Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer (RDMS) credential.

- 1. ARDMS Sonography Principles and Instrumentation (SPI) Exam
- 2. American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) Exam
- 3. ARDMS Speciality Exam for employment eligibility

Admissions Requirements

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and have completed a minimum of 9 units from a combination of any of the following prerequisite courses with a grade of "C" or higher at an accredited college or

- Writing and Composition
- Intermediate Algebra or higher
- Anatomy and Physiology
- Medical Terminology

Nine units of prerequisite coursework will be applied to the general education graduation requirement.

Applicants who have successfully completed the prerequisites will be considered for admission into the program. Using a point-based system, applicants will be ranked on the following criteria: cumulative GPA on prerequisite courses, an assessment, professional references, and a personal interview with program faculty. Enrollment decisions are made by the Program Director or his/her designee.

Career Opportunities

Graduates will be prepared to work as an entry level diagnostic medical sonographer in a variety of settings such as a hospital, physician's office, or diagnostic center. These health technicians typically perform the following job duties:**

- Prepare patients for procedures by taking a patient's history and answering any questions about the
- Clean, check, and maintain sonographic equipment
- Operate equipment to get diagnostic images of areas in the patient's body
- Provide sonogram and oral or written summary of technical findings to physician for use in medical
- Record findings and keep track of patients' records

SJVC prepares students to take appropriate certification and licensure exams related to their individual majors. The College does not quarantee students will successfully pass these exams or be certified or licensed as a result of completing the program.
