

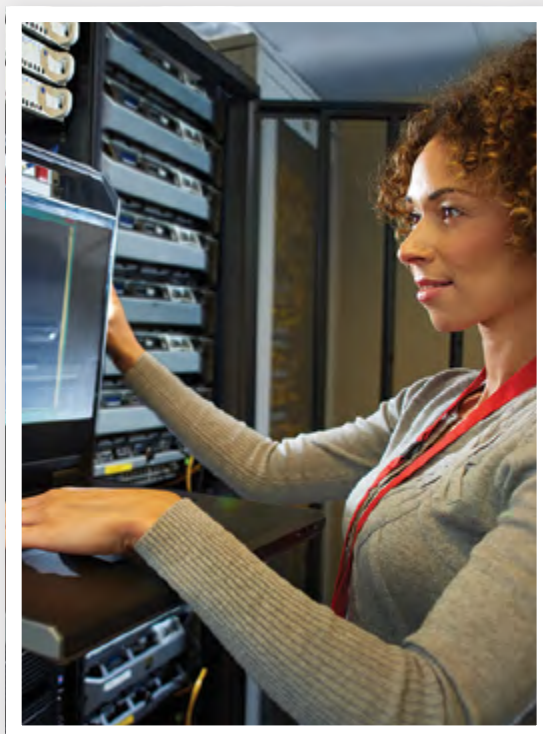
SJVC's online Information Technology (IT) program provides students with the knowledge and skills for a variety of entry-level careers in the Information Technology industry.
