Professional Certifications

The Certificate credential level prepares students to take the Certified Professional Coder (CPC) exam. This exam is administered by the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC). The A.S. Degree prepares students to take both the Certified Professional Coder (CPC) and Certified Professional Biller (CPB) certification examinations, which are administered by the AAPC. Test preparation and voucher(s) to take the exam(s) are included with the program. Certificate and A.S. Degree graduates earn a typing certificate and HIPAA certification.

Career Information

Well-trained Medical Billing and Coding personnel can work for hospitals, insurance companies, medical and dental offices, healthcare clinics and more. These technicians perform the following job duties:

- Assemble patient health information and review records
- Code and process patient insurance claims
- Protect patient health information
