Graduation Rates

The graduation rate of first-time, full-time students who started between the timeframe of September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016 and completed their program of study within 150% of the normal projected timeframe is 47%. The table below provides the graduation rates by gender, ethnicity, and receipt/non-receipt of Federal student financial aid.

Retention Rates

The retention rate of first-time, full-time students who began their program of study in Fall 2016 (August 1, 2016 – October 31, 2016) and are still enrolled or who have completed their studies as of the second academic year is 49%. The retention rates for first-time, full-time students for the Fall 2016 cohort by campus are provided in the table below. The institutional and campus retention rates were calculated using the IPEDS formula.
