



## 2022 STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW DISCLOSURES

### Graduation Rates

The graduation rate of first-time, full-time students who started between the timeframe of September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016 at Visalia, or September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019 for all other locations, and completed their program of study within 150% of the normal projected timeframe is **55%**. The table below provides the graduation rates by gender, ethnicity, and receipt/non-receipt of Federal student financial aid.

## Retention Rates

The retention rate of first-time, full-time degree seeking students who began their program of study in Fall 2020 (August 1, 2020 – October 31, 2020) and are still enrolled or who have completed their studies as of the end of Fall 2021 (October 31, 2021) year is **65%**. The retention rates for first-time, full-time students for the Fall 2020 cohort by campus are provided in the table below. The institutional and campus retention rates were calculated using the IPEDS formula. If a Campus does not appear in the list below then there were no first-time, full-time entering students in Fall 2020.
