Completion of the full CSU or UC IGETC certification (CA), Washington and Oregon state-approved Direct Transfer degrees or other state's equivalent transfer certification prior to the student being admitted, enrolled and attending his/her first session in a bachelor degree program at Brandman satisfies all Brandman University GE requirements except LBSU 300. Students who matriculate to Brandman with partial GE certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.

Lower division courses may be eligible to fulfill upper division major requirements if approved by the Dean of Business and Professional Studies.

Major includes 72 semester credits of course requirements. See the catalog for a full list of major requirements.

All courses must be taken for a letter grade. Courses may be used to fulfill both major and general education requirements.

<p>Degree Requirements</p> <p>In addition to the University General Education and elective requirements, the BBA major consists of three components. The first component consists of 18 lower-division Core Requirements. The second component consists of 33 credits of upper-division BBA requirements. The third component consists of 21 credits of Business electives or 21 credits of specialized courses in a selected area of Emphasis.</p> <p><i>CSU-transferable college courses in business-related subject areas may apply toward the 21 credit elective requirement. Contact the Brandman University Student Services Department for more information.</i></p>	

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The following information is a guide of San Joaquin Valley College courses that transfer to Brandman University to fulfill general education requirements.

GE Block Transfer

Brandman accepts the full CSU or UC IGETC general education certification to satisfy all GE requirements except LBSU 300, LBSU 302 and University Degree Qualifications. The University Degree Qualifications may be completed through residential coursework taken in the major or through residential electives.

Certification must be completed prior to the student's first term admitted, enrolled and attending. Students who matriculate to Brandman with partial GE certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.

Courses may be approved for more than one area but can only be applied towards one requirement

The exact number of elective credits depends on the credit requirements (9 to 12) of a student's selected concentration. Thus, if a student selects a concentration that has a 12	

credit requirement, then the student will take one (1) elective course. Students may choose from criminal justice, organizational leadership, political science, psychology, social science, and sociology courses to satisfy major elective requirements.
