This articulation agreement provides transfer options for qualified graduates of San Joaquin Valley College (SJVC) interested in continuing their education by obtaining their bachelor degrees with Cambridge College/Inland Empire Regional Center (Cambridge).

Terms of Agreement

Duties and Responsibilities of SJVC:

I. Review/Renewal: SJVC agrees to review agreement periodically and revise as necessary and by mutual consent. Renewal will take place every three (3) years or as mutually agreed upon by both parties.

II. Notice of Curriculum Changes: SJVC will notify Cambridge in writing and in a timely manner of program changes that might affect the transfer of graduates under this agreement.

III. Articulation College Promotion: SJVC agrees to work collaboratively with Cambridge on mutually approved efforts to provide SJVC graduates and prospective graduates with information about Cambridge bachelor degree program opportunities. These efforts include *passive marketing approaches only*, such as posting Cambridge website on the SJVC portal and placing Cambridge brochures in designated student activity areas.

Duties and Responsibilities of Cambridge:

Cambridge will honor this agreement for applicable SJVC graduates upon the completion of Cambridge's admissions process. There are no entrance exams required. There are applications and references to be completed by the enrolling students.
