



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT WITH SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY COLLEGE AND CARRINGTON COLLEGE

San Joaquin Valley College (SJVC) and Carrington College and have entered into this Articulation Agreement in the spirit of cooperation and to mutually recognize each other as quality institutions of higher learning. The purpose of the Agreement is to enable Carrington College students who transfer to SJVC to carry with them the maximum applicable credit they have already earned. The Articulation Agreement provides a structure through which transfer articulation on the following identified levels can be supported. Students may pursue their academic and professional goals through one of the following bachelor's degrees offered at SJVC, provided they meet all admissions requirements for the chosen degree program.

Carrington College graduates transferring to SJVC for a Baccalaureate degree, must have a minimum of a conferred Associate degree from Carrington College, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, entering under the terms of this agreement.

The minimum transfer credit to SJVC is 60 units for those that obtained their Associate degree from Carrington College. The maximum transfer credit to SJVC under this agreement is 80 units. SJVC will accept the following Associate degrees from Carrington College graduates as a block transfer of credit. The Associate Program degrees and the number of units eligible for transfer are listed by program major in the following table.

Terms of Agreement


Duties and Responsibilities of Carrington College:

1. Review/Renewal: Carrington College agrees to review agreement periodically and revise as necessary and by mutual consent. Renewal will take place every 3 years from the date this agreement is signed or as mutually agreed upon by both parties.
2. Notice of Curriculum Changes: Carrington College will notify SJVC in writing and in a timely manner of program changes that might affect the transfer of graduates under this agreement. Any reduction in the number of units granted in the Associate Degrees (that are listed in this agreement) must be provided to SJVC on an immediate basis.
3. Articulation College Promotion: Carrington College agrees to work collaboratively with SJVC on mutually approved efforts to provide Carrington College graduates and prospective graduates with information about the SJVC Baccalaureate degree program opportunities.

Duties and Responsibilities of San Joaquin Valley College:

San Joaquin Valley College will honor this agreement for applicable Carrington College graduates upon the completion of the admissions process.


