The Committee on Substantive Change of the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges met November 6, 2014 to review the two Substantive Change Proposals from San Joaquin Valley College for the new Delano campus location and the Information Technology program to be offered at 50% or more via distance education or electronic delivery.

The Committee acted to approve both of the requests. The new Delano campus will require a federally mandated site visit to the campus within six months of operation.

Due to recent changes in the U.S. Department of Education regulations, two evaluators are now required to accompany the ACCJC staff when conducting a site visit. This will be arranged when the College is planning for the visit.

It remains the College's responsibility to inform the Commission of any program change.
