Dear Mr. Gomez:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACCJC/Commission) received on August 24, 2021, your request to voluntarily withdraw from ACCJC's membership, effective August 25, 2021. This request follows the necessary approvals your college received from the Bureau of Private Postsecondary Education, as well as notification that the U.S. Department of Education (ED) approved the Western Association of Schools and Colleges - Senior College & University Commission (WSCUC) as San Joaquin Valley College's primary accreditor for purposes of participation in Title IV, Higher Education Act programs.

The Commission Executive Committee took action to accept San Joaquin Valley College's request to voluntarily withdraw from membership in ACCJC, effective August 25, 2021. Per federal policy, the Commission will notify the U.S. Secretary of Education and other officials of ED, appropriate state licensing and/or authorizing agencies, and the appropriate accrediting bodies.

In keeping with ACCJC policy, the Commission action will also be posted on the ACCJC website within 30 days of the date of the action. ACCJC requires that you disclose the Commission's action to all current and prospective students within seven business days of receipt of the Commission's action. San Joaquin Valley College will no longer be listed as a current member institution on the ACCJC directory. However, the college will be included in the list of previously accredited institutions maintained on the ACCJC website.

On behalf of the Commission and ACCJC staff, we wish San Joaquin Valley College continued success in its endeavors to provide quality education to its students.
