- **3. Demonstrate** the ability to access, interpret, and critically appraise relevant medical and other authoritative literature related to clinical practice, administration, education, and/or research associated with the respiratory therapy profession and potentially affect positive change within your department.

Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to the Respiratory Therapy Bachelor Degree Completion Program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Hold an Associate of Science Degree in Respiratory Care from a CoARC or CAAHEP accredited Associate of Science degree respiratory therapy program
- Successful completion of a minimum of 70.0 units of lower division courses (may include lower division respiratory care coursework)
- Hold an active credential as a Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT), and current unencumbered licensure as a Respiratory Care Practitioner (RCP) in California or in the state of current employment


