Description of Electronic Library and Learning Resources

Database Collections: The College Library has a database collection that covers a wide range of subject areas that support student success across all program offerings. The database collection includes access to 45 different databases that provide users with millions of peer-reviewed and full-text journal and newspaper articles, eBooks, podcasts, images, and video and audio resources. For example, the Academic and the General OneFile database collections offer over 34,000 titles of resources in a variety of subjects, including science and technology, psychology, education, and many others.

eBooks: The Gale Virtual Reference Library provides access to over 2,800 full-text reference eBooks that cover a wide range of subjects. Students in the medical or allied health fields have access to the Gale Nursing & Allied Health, Health Reference Center Academic, and Health and Wellness Resource Collections which combined offer access to over 9,000 titles, including journals, pamphlets, eBooks, videos, and other related resources. There is also a video database for the Veterinary Technician students—Veterinary Education in Video—that allows students to watch veterinary professionals work with animals in a variety of settings.

Ebook Central, the College's main source of ebooks, provides users with access to over 150,000 titles relating to subjects such as science and technology, general interest, health and medical, social science, and many more.
