Conflict of Interest Statement for Board Governors

If the Board has reasonable cause to believe that a member has failed to disclose actual or possible conflicts of interest, it will provide the member an opportunity to explain the situation. If, after hearing the response of the member and making such further investigation as appropriate, the Board determines that the member has failed to disclose an actual or possible conflict of interest, the member is subject to termination from the Board.

The San Joaquin Valley College Board of Governors' Conflict of Interest Policy, which can be found on page 18 of the Board of Governors' Handbook (September 2017), is as follows:

The term "conflict of interest" is defined as an act, interest, or will that may interfere with the impartiality of serving on the Board or that may interfere with the duty to secure and ensure the academic and fiscal integrity of the College. Conflicts of interest refer to situations in which outside relationships or activities may adversely affect a Board member's commitment to his/her Board duties and/or responsibilities.


The Board of Governors recognizes that members of the Board may find themselves in a position where their personal interests may conflict with their duties to the College. Each member is expected to self-reflect and assess his or her own involvement with outside interests to ensure that these are not in conflict with their Board service. If a member(s) feels that any potential conflict of interest exists, he/she is expected to discuss this issue immediately with the Board of Directors.

Any Board member who believes a conflict of interest exists with another member's service on the Board should immediately bring this to the attention of the Board of Directors. Reporting a known or suspected conflict of interest is not considered an act of disloyalty, but is an action that shows a sense of responsibility that will help safeguard the reputation of the College and its constituents.

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

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
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
