Questions to evaluate how well students are learning - A significant piece of the program review process

COURSE MEASURES

Analysis – Evaluating CLO achievement.

- 1. What CLOs did not meet benchmark?
 - a. Is this consistent with the other assessments you are giving in the course?
- 2. What are your insights to why these CLO benchmarks weren't met?
 - a. Is the CLO difficult to teach?
 - b. Is the CLO difficult to learn?
 - c. Is the CLO difficult to assess?
 - d. Time constraints?
- 3. What improvements to teaching and learning can be implemented to improve CLO achievement for courses not meeting target?

Observations – Upon viewing the data presented, what are the first things you identify?

- 1. Do you observe any trends or patterns in the data?
- 2. What is your overall impression of the health of the program?

Analysis – Comparing Attendance with the Course Completion Rate.
