<p style="text-align: center;">Learning Outcome Focus</p> <p>The instructor provides clearly stated learning outcomes.</p> <p>Examples: Uses a formative approach to evaluate student progress toward achieving learning outcomes; actively monitors student understanding and motivation; recognizes student growth toward achieving learning outcomes.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of instructor providing clearly stated learning outcomes.</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor providing clearly stated learning outcomes.</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor using innovative and creative techniques to seamlessly integrate learning outcomes into instruction.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Instructional Strategies</p> <p>The instructor incorporates a variety of instructional strategies to add interest and enhance learning.</p> <p>Examples: Scans the classroom, incorporates activities, manages response rate, incorporates physical movement, keeps a lively pace, includes intensity and enthusiasm, engages in friendly debate, provides opportunity for student self-sharing, and presents unusual/intriguing information.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe-</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of a variety of instructional strategies being utilized</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor utilizing a variety of instructional strategies</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor utilizing a variety of instructional strategies, with special attention paid to the incorporation of a variety of learning styles.</p>	

<p style="text-align: center;">Learning Environment</p> <p>The instructor constructs an environment that is safe and conducive to learning.</p> <p>Examples: Sets and holds students accountable to rules and policies, continually monitors student behaviors, consistently applies consequences when rules and procedures are not followed, and positively recognizes adherence to expectations.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of instructor constructing a learning environment that is safe and conducive to learning.</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor constructing a learning environment that is safe and conducive to learning</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor using innovative and creative techniques to establish a professional learning community</p>	
<p>The instructor structures the class to ensure students are fully engaged</p> <p>Examples: Requiring participation from all students, using verbal and nonverbal behaviors that indicate caring for the student and/or remaining unbiased and professional.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of instructor structuring the class to ensure students are fully engaged</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor structuring the class to ensure students are fully engaged</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor using innovative and creative techniques to integrate students' interests into the lesson, thus ensuring that students are fully engaged</p>	

<p style="text-align: center;">Acquiring New Knowledge</p> <p>Instructor provides opportunities for students to process new information.</p> <p>Examples: Distinguishes which content is critical v. noncritical, provides opportunity for students to collaborate on new knowledge, points out connections to previous knowledge, utilizes “chunking”, asks stimulating questions, caters to a variety of learning styles, and/or encourages reflection of learning.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of instructor providing opportunities for students to process new information</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor providing opportunities for students to process new information</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor using creativity in the creation of innovative opportunities for students to process new information. techniques to create</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Application</p> <p>The instructor provides opportunities for students to deepen their understanding of content.</p> <p>Examples: Engages students in review activities, provides opportunity for students to collaborate and practice with knowledge, and/ or assigns activities and coursework designed to deepen student knowledge.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of instructor providing opportunities for students to deepen their understanding of content.</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor providing opportunities for students to deepen their understanding of content</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor using creativity in the creation of innovative opportunities for students to deepen their understanding of content.</p>	

<p style="text-align: center;">Cognitive Complexity</p> <p>The instructor organizes the class to provide a cognitively complex and learner-centered environment with stimulating tasks.</p> <p>Examples: Decision-making, problem solving, experimental inquiry, or investigation.</p> <p>Not Observed: No opportunity to observe</p> <p>Needs Improvement: Although called for, no observable evidence of instructor organizing the class to provide a cognitively complex and learner-centered environment with stimulating tasks.</p> <p>Meets Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor organizing the class to provide a cognitively complex and learner-centered environment with stimulating tasks.</p> <p>Exceeds Expectations: Observable evidence of instructor using creativity and innovation to construct learning opportunities which inspire higher-order thinking.</p>
