This online course will provide a comprehensive overview of the ACCJC's Accreditation Standards and Eligibility Requirements. You can access the course on the ACCJC's

At the end of the course, you will take an online assessment. If you receive a passing score on the assessment, you will be given the option to print a Certificate of Completion. Please print the Certificate and forward it to the Board's Secretary. If you do not receive a passing score, please retake the course.
