Program Outcomes

- Current Exam Pass Rates for RDH Licensure:
 - National Board: 94.0%
 - State Board: 91.0%
- Current Placement Rates: 82%
- Graduation/Completion Rates: 96%



Visalia & Rancho Cucamonga - Dental Hygiene Program Locations



















Program Specifics

- Consists of two academic years;
 completed in approximately 16 months
- Enrolls 20 to 36 students per class
- Instructs two classes a first year class and a second year class
- Clinical Faculty to Student Ratio: 1:5
- Operates the DH clinics between 90-100% capacity during clinic sessions
- Maintains 100% participation in SADHA



CODA Updates

- January 2012: CODA's acceptance of SJVC's initial accreditation application
- April 19, 2012: Site Visit
- August 9, 2012: Commission Meeting – Site Evaluation Report voted on
- November 2012: Anticipated Start Date
