PURPOSE

ACCJC POLICY

ACCJC Standard I. B. 3. reads: “The institution establishes institution-set standards for student achievement, appropriate to its mission, assesses how well it is achieving them in pursuit of continuous improvement, and publishes this information.”¹

1. This Standard envisions that an institution will determine key performance measures by which it will both monitor (floor) and challenge (aspirational goal) its overall effectiveness in terms of student achievement. Rather than cede to an external body the authority to determine acceptable levels of performance, an institution takes into account its mission, constituencies, and programs to determine its own appropriate levels of performance.

HISTORICAL REVIEW

- During previously WASC accreditation cycle, SJVC learned of the need to determine Institutional Standards for select student outcome metrics
- Review of WASC materials and phone conference trainings
- Selected 4 areas for Institutional Set Standards based on guidance from Barbara Beno, ACCJC President
 - Course Completion
 - Graduation
 - Placement
 - Licensure/Certification

CURRENT THRESHOLDS

Standard	Threshold
Course Completion	100% completed at 90% or better
Graduation	60%
Placement	65%
Certification/ Licensure	90% achievement of scores at 75% or programmatic requirement (whichever is higher)

COMMITTEE MEMBERS ROLE

- Review changes in external and internal environment as they relate to these standards
 - Regulatory changes in definition (BPPE, placement)
 - Impact of GE on degree offerings
 - Additional campus and program offerings
 - Demographic changes

In order to obtain an RRT credential, which is required for employment in CA, grads must pass the TMC exam with the higher of two thresholds; attaining the lower threshold awards only the CRT (which does not allow for employment in CA); attaining the higher threshold allows the candidate to then sit for the Clinical Simulation Exam (CSE). Only upon passing the CSE is the RRT credential awarded. While programs are required to meet 80% for CRT, there is no current threshold for RRT. However, as CA requires RRT for employment, an INTERNAL threshold of 80% has been suggested by Greg O. to ensure that we are maintaining a high rate of licensure and assist placement. Greg feels that as more states move toward RRT requirements for employment, CoARC may indeed institute a threshold for it.
